## DEAF CHILD AREA WARNING SIGN GUIDELINE

The city of Tulsa will provide DEAF CHILD AREA warning sign in front of the residence of a hearing impaired child between the ages of 2 and 12 under the following guidelines:

- 1. The request must be made in writing by the parent. The letter must contain parent's name, address, phone number, child's name, and child's birth date. The request should be sent to the city Traffic Engineer, 200 Civic Center, Room 633, Tulsa, OK 74103.
- 2. Signs will not be provided on major arterial streets nor in front of multi-family housing complexes.
- 3. The signs will be 30" x 30" yellow and black diamond shaped warning signs with the legend DEAF CHILD AREA. They will be mounted with the bottom of the sign seven feet above the ground. Specific locations will be chosen which will reduce as much as possible any impact on neighbors' property.
- 4. It is very important that unneeded warning signs be removed. Therefore, it is requested that the parents notify Traffic Operations upon moving from this address. In addition this office will write each family in November of each year requesting written confirmation of continued residence and of a continued desire that the signs remain. When the child reaches his or her twelfth birthday the signs will be removed.
