

### **Directional Signing Guideline For Primary and Secondary Schools**

**Intent:** Defines those schools eligible for on-street directional guide signing.

**Guideline:** Public and private primary and secondary schools in general generate predictable traffic that repeats from day-to-day. Weekends are an exception. The composition of generated traffic to these schools is largely students, parents of students, educators and school staff, all of which are familiar with the school location. This known, it is surmised that directional on-street signing to these schools is typically not required.

Exception to aforesaid would be secondary schools that hold events attracting large crowds of people, some which are not familiar with the school location. Directional signing then may be considered after conducting an engineering evaluation.

In the location placement of on-street directional school signing, regulatory and warning sign locations will take precedent over on-street school directional signing. Manufacture, installation and placement of signs will be in accordance with the latest revision of *the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices* handbook and will be by the City of Tulsa Public Works, Traffic Operations.
