IMPLEMENTING STAGE 1 – VOLUNTARY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the current water system delivery as filed with the City Clerk is 220 million gallons per day (mgd);

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2011 water usage exceeded ninety-four (94%) of the City of Tulsa's ability to deliver potable water to its customers by means of its water system;

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2011 water usage again exceeded ninety-four (94%) of the City of Tulsa's ability to deliver potable water to its customers by means of its water system:

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that conditions exist that may harm the public health, safety and welfare;

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. IMPLEMENTING STAGE 1 – VOLUNTARY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

In accordance with Tulsa Revised Ordinance Title 11-C – Waterworks and Sewerage, the Mayor hereby calls upon the general population to conserve water voluntarily by limiting outside watering to the hours between midnight and noon every other day.


Those customers whose street address ends with an odd number are encouraged to water only on odd numbered calendar days and those customers whose street address ends with an even number are encouraged to water only on even numbered calendar days.

Section 2. TERMINATION OF STAGE 1


Stage 1 shall terminate when the Mayor files an order with the City Clerk, finding that the conditions for Stage 1 no longer exist.


Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall take effect immediately.
