## EXECUTIVE ORDER REGARDING THE MAYOR'S VETERANS ADVISORY COUNCIL

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

- Section 1. <u>Creation of the Mayor's Veterans Advisory Council.</u> There is hereby created the Mayor's Veterans Advisory Council (MVAC), to be comprised of no more than 23 people to include, but not limited to representing the following; education, mental health, housing, returning Operation Enduring Freedom veterans, Operation Iraqi Freedom veterans, World War II veterans, Korea veterans, Vietnam veterans and the Persian Gulf War veterans. All members of the MVAC shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.
- Section 2. <u>Duties of the Council.</u> The MVAC shall advise the Mayor's Office on public policy relating to Tulsa's veterans, service members and their families. The MVAC shall determine how often it meets, but it shall meet as least quarterly. The MVAC shall advise the Mayor on a full spectrum of veterans', service member and family member needs. The MVAC shall also advise the Mayor about ways the City of Tulsa can best address the interests of veterans, service members and their families. Members of the MVAC shall adopt their own rules and procedures.
- **Section 3.** <u>Department Cooperation.</u> All departments, boards, agencies and committees under the Mayor's supervision and control are hereby directed to cooperate with the MVAC in the performance of any of its designated tasks.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect immediately on the date written below.
